MPLA/SDLA/NDLA 2013 Tri-conference Update:

On February 19, 2013, the Tri-Conference Programming Committee met via teleconference. Participants included Jan Brue Enright (SDLA), Scott Ahola (SDLA), Al Peterson (NDLA), Aubrey Madler (NDLA), JaNae Kinikin (MPLA), and Wendy Wendt (MPLA).

The following items were discussed:

Conference Session Proposals:

More than 80 tri-conference session proposals were received from states throughout the MPLA region, including Texas, Wyoming, Oklahoma, Arizona, Utah, Kansas, New Mexico, Arizona, Colorado, Nebraska, as well as North Dakota and South Dakota. Our MPLA members submitted incredible session proposals and represented the Association well.

It was truly difficult to winnow down these great submissions into the time available. In addition to the pre-conferences, there will be 8 concurrent breakout sessions during 4 slots on Thursday and 7 concurrent breakouts sessions during 3 slots on Friday. During this teleconference, we narrowed down the selections, with an eye on providing a fairly equal distribution of sessions for public, school, and academic libraries, as well as general sessions.

One timeslot has been reserved for the MPLA Professional Forum, which is tentatively scheduled as a breakout session at 8:30 Friday morning.
