- The MPLA/KLA Program Planning Committee met most recently on April 16th. The call for
 proposals went out earlier this spring and the proposals are steadily coming in. So far there are
 38 program proposals. 13 were submitted for MPLA and 8 for 'either'. The deadline for proposal
 submission is June 15 and programs will be selected in July. Once this happens, the conference
 grid will be constructed.
- There was discussion about both the opening and closing keynote speaker and the information was deferred to the Conference Planning Committee. The Program Planning committee will meet again May 17.
