• Have you ever wondered what the busiest time of the day is on the website, in terms of number of hits per hour? From 6-11am, this is the "dead time" at around 25,000 hits per hour – not average hits, but hits total. Starting about 1pm, traffic increases, to peak from 3pm-10pm, at over 175,000 hits per hour.

 - o April 2006 MPLA Newsletter: 2,377 times
 - o June 2005 MPLA Newsletter: 2,105 times
 - o In general, you would be surprised at the number of times the 2003 and 2005 Conference Handouts Archive files are being accessed even years after the fact.
 - o Images by and large, particularly conference images from previous years are accessed quite frequently (over 200 times per image) Some of Sharon's photos from the 2003 conference in Tahoe were looked at over 500 times last year. Again, go figure.

 - o Google.com: 15,926
 - o Libraryjobpostings.com: 9.925
 - o Lisjobs.com: 6,450
