- The 2012-2013 budget passed in the CO House 60 to 1 with revenue projections still looking good.
- K-12 received more money and the proposed Senior Citizen rebate was approved to an extent
- <u>Massey's Literacy bill</u>: passed house and passed 2nd reading in Senate with modifications.
