Legislative News

- Calling for support for U.S. Senators to fully fund the Government Printing Office (GPO) and the request for an additional \$7 million for the Federal Digital System (FDsys).
- Budget Update indicates an unexpected revenue increase that will be will be primarily directed towards education and possibly library services. Early Literacy is a hot issue that is supported by the Lieutenant Governor and may be an area of focus as well.
- Lobato v. Colorado is still on the radar as the Colorado Attorney General attempts to reverse the court ruling in favor of plaintiff.

CAL Board Meeting – June 2012

- Discussed the 2012 Leadership Institute with board members and distributed the reading list to those who showed interest. Hopefully this will make the Institute more tangible to CAL board members.
