## **Legislative Updates**

- Funding for Libraries
  - The Library Line Item is already in place which will make things easier for us; the issue will be insuring that it stays in place. As the legislative session starts, we should focus on conversations with the JBC members. As budget approval nears in March, the membership-as-a-whole should start talking about the line item with their legislators.
  - There is a discussion about asking for a referendum which asks voters to not have to do a refund. It won't impact the refunds for this year, but could impact refunds for future...also assuming the split party control over the two houses will let something go forward.
  - We will ask for an increase for Libraries but keep it general. There may be a little more money in the General Fund but we will be competing with other groups. To discuss with legislators, should move from literacy to Workforce Development – focus on helping the middle class which is still hurting. This can be logical as libraries work with WorkForce Development Offices.
