
# ST-2 COLORADO REPORT TO MPLA BOARD **DECEMBER 11, 2020**



#### **MPLA Activities**

- Reviewed submitted reports for the December 11, 2020 meeting.
- Monitored MPLA email account.

### Colorado Activities

- Attended the October 9th and November 13th CAL Board meetings.
- Ran to serve as Colorado's MPLA representative from 2021 through 2023. The election results will be posted in December 2020 or January 2021.



## **COVID-19 Impact on Library Services**

In September and October, most Colorado public libraries had reopened access to facilities to a limited number of patrons at a time. Campus and school services included both onsite and online options to their students.

In mid-November, most counties were moved to a heightened alert status due the continued increase number of COVID19-related hospitalizations. As a result, public

libraries have either reduced the numbers of people allowed in facilities or have returned to curbside-only. Most campuses and schools have returned to online-only services through winter break and will reassess for the spring session.

### Legislative Updates

- Attended the November 6<sup>th</sup> CAL Legislative Committee meeting.
- Libraries that rely on property tax revenues may see increased stability as the Gallagher Amendment's limits on residential property tax was repealed. Residential taxes will be frozen at 7.15%.



- The Governor recognized libraries as a critical service.
- The Colorado Legislature held an Extraordinary Session that started on November 30<sup>th</sup> to make decisions on bills focused on COVID-19 relief for small businesses, childcare providers, and community support services.
- The regular legislative session begins January 8, 2021.
