Oberlander has been a utility economist with the New Mexico Public Regulation Commission since 2000. She was the Director of Libraries and the Library Technology degree program at Northern New Mexico Community College for 14 years, 1978-1992. Oberlander holds a Master of Library Science from the University of Oklahoma, as well as a doctorate from the School of Information Management and Systems at the University of California Berkeley. "The State Library's mission to provide leadership that empowers libraries to support the educational, economic, and health goals of their communities is both facilitated and complicated by the digital age," said Oberlander. "I look forward to becoming the State Librarian for New Mexico in this exciting technological time." Oberlander replaces Richard Akeroyd, who resigned his position in April after serving as State Librarian since August 2003. She will assume her responsibilities on July 2.
