The Board is working to implement more rigid budgeting guidelines and is evaluating increasing registration fees, levying CE instructor fees, avoiding more expensive host facilities, and securing sponsorships to help ensure that we at least break even at future conferences.

North Dakota News

- The North Dakota State Library's biennial budget originally included an increased appropriation for State Aid to Public Libraries and money to be granted to public libraries for renovations and repairs (HB1013). Despite being part of the Governor's budget, the House removed the increase in State Aid to Public Libraries and the funding for library renovation and repair grants from the bill. The Senate hearing for the bill is this week.
